

# ASQ-3 Training

Learn how to use the  
**Ages and Stages Questionnaires\*** screening tool  
in your child care program.



The ASQ-3 can be used with children from 1 month to 5½ years of age.  
**You can use the ASQ-3 to learn about children's skills.**

This will help you:

- Plan a developmentally-appropriate curriculum
- Talk with parents about their children's development
- Identify when a child might need extra support
- Determine potential eligibility for Resource Consultant service

This training is for anyone who has not yet learned how to use the ASQ-3 and anyone who was trained before but wants a refresher.
